5 YEAR WARRANTY


&Tradition provides a 5-year warranty with every Archivo Shelf, which covers faults present at the time of purchase, or those which have occurred as a result of a manufacturing defect. The warranty is valid from the date stated on the original invoice.

DISASSEMBLY


1. Before starting the disassembly, remove all objects from the unit and detach the shelf from the wall. To do so, remove the screws from the brackets that connect the shelf to the wall using a screwdriver.




2. Carefully flip the shelf upside down. Ensure you have an additional person to perform this action safely.




3. Begin the disassembly of the shelf with the feet. Remove the screws from the underside of the shelf by turning them counterclockwise. Once removed, detach each column and repeat this process for each level of the shelf.



4. Separate the gliders from the feet by unscrewing them counterclockwise.



5. Finally, remove all the threaded inserts from the shelf boards as well as the feet. To do this, use a larger Allen key (not provided with the product) and turn it counterclockwise.
