



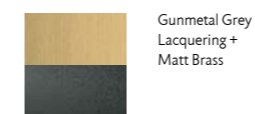
ERA TABLE

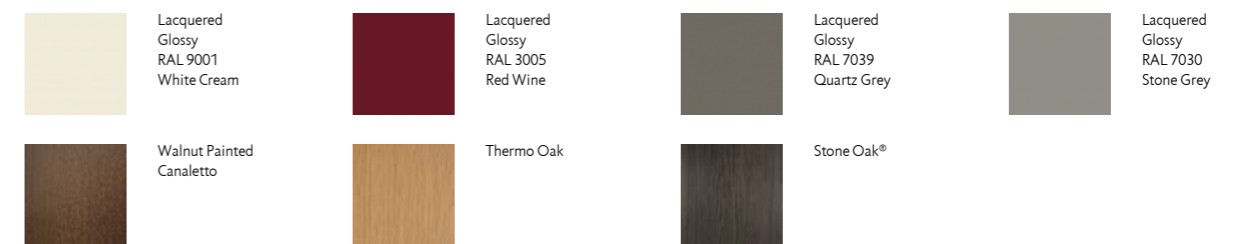
Family of side tables in different shapes, sizes, and heights, with external frame in 5mm thick steel sheet, laser-cut from a single piece. Tops in 8 mm thick laminated HPL, shaped and veneered in Stone Oak®, natural oak, or walnut painted "Canaletto", or finished with glossy lacquer in RAL 3005 Wine Red, RAL 7030 Stone Grey, RAL 7039 Quartz Grey, RAL 9001 Cream White, fixed to the frame with plastic components.

Legs in Ø12 mm steel tube elements with 11 cm high spacers and brass feet, fixed to the external frame with a threaded rod and brass bushing. Floor support provided by plastic tips. Metal parts with epoxy polyester powder coating in Gunmetal grey color. Brass parts satin-finished with matte paint. For the sizes 90x90 cm, 60x160 cm, and Ø120 cm, a central foot is included.

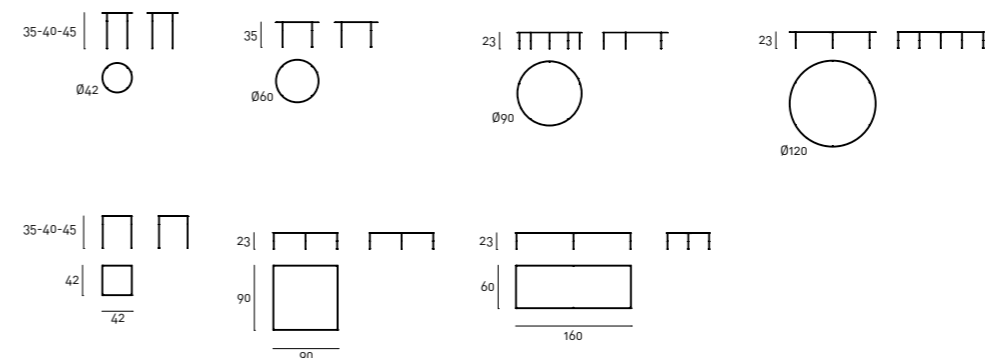

Notes

Wood is a living material; therefore, it can have slight color and dimension changes. The presence of any non-homogeneous color shades is not to be considered a defect but a quality. Please note that the direct sunlight exposure may alter the wood color; therefore, we recommend the periodic position shift of the objects placed on the furniture for the first months to avoid differences in shades between exposed and covered portions.

STONE OAK®: this wood owes its particular coloring to an entirely natural process. Because of this, some slabs may look more brown than others. Our commitment is to provide you a high-quality product; any differences in color should not be considered as defects. For further information about this wood, please refer to the technical sheet available in the "Materials" section on our website.

On request, an additional protective (acrylic solvent) painting is available for the Stone Oak® finishing only. It should be noted that this additional coating slightly changes the natural color and texture of the surface. Although this supplementary painting increases the surface resistance, it is still a natural material; therefore, small superficial stains, due to oil or other substances, must be promptly removed, before being absorbed in depth by the wood. Thus, we recommend regular care and maintenance.
